Proposed amendments to IAMCR's Standing Orders (bylaws)

Amendment of S. 8.1 of the by-laws

8.1 Subject to Articles 6, 7 and 8 of the Statutes, an Election Committee of three members shall be appointed by the International Council during the year preceding the vote to manage the whole election process, from calling for candidates to counting the votes and announcing the results. The Committee shall seek to encourage candidates to express their positions and engage in dialogue among themselves and with the memebrships as annronriate'

Amendment of S. 8.3.2 of the bylaws

 8.3.2.Each candidate shall send to the Chair of the Election Committee a confirmation of their candidacy and an election statement that conforms to the guidelines established by the Election Committee which are to be approved by the International Council. Both documents should be sent electronically at least 120 days before the relevant session of the General Assembly. [Each candidate shall send] a curriculum vitae and/or statement of no more than 200 words, either electronically or by registered mail, to the Chair of the Election

Amendment of S. 8.3.5 of the bylaws

- 8.3.5.The Election Committee will validate the list of candidates and it will be published on the Website with their statements. The Committee will ensure that the list of candidates and their statements are made available to the members, will provide guidelines to the candidates for the election campaigns and will inform them about election procedures. These guidelines need to be approved by the International Council.
