IAMCR Chinese PhD/Mast Member Forum

Possible themes:

- Voice for IAMCR PhD/Master members

<u>Grant:</u> Seek possibilities to base the annual event in Faculty of Journalism and Communication, Communication University of China (CUC) collaborated with faulty member. And we will try to apply for a special grant for international academic activities from CUC.

- Promote opportunities for the presentation of IAMCR to student participants the biggest conferences on journalism and communication in China where possible, including The Chinese Association for History of Journalism and Mass Communication, Chinese Collegial Association for Visual Art, etc.
- Collaborate with PhD academic groups from different universities, try to build up a PhD research community under the basic framework of IAMCR.
- Organize open days for Chinese university students (once a year maximum), give them introduction of IAMCR events and membership application, invite current Master and

PhD members to share their experiences and stories with IAMCR.

• Try to strengthen the connection between IAMCR faculty members and student members by organizing special seminars or workshops where scholars and experts are invited to give talks and provide advices for student members' research project and career planning.

On task 1

- Make IAMCR known to Chinese academia, scholars and university students as a preeminent worldwide association in the field of media and communication research, and communicate its important events, via a wide range of conferences, seminars, lectures and workshops, etc.
- Set up a Facebook group to post our activities and achievements regularly, particularly help Chinese Master and PhD IAMCR members to improve their visibility internationally, seek more connections and collaborations with other IAMCR ambassadors and members outside China.
- Create a channel on TikTok to record and present IAMCR ambassador's work, and our regular/special events, works.
- Generate micro video interviews with Chinese IAMCR members and promotional posters

On task 2

- Generate a list of Chinese IAMCR members who are either based in China or abroad.
- Set up a WeChat group to provide a platform for Chinese IAMCR members, to promote daily socializing and connection, inter-university and cross-field cooperation, communicating important IAMCR events and announcements.
- Organize IAMCR members' informal talks (once a year), collect Chinese IAMCR members' suggestions comments, questions about the IAMCR PhD ambassador's wok and development of IAMCR.

On task 5

- Try to arrange a special IAMCR panel via negotiation and application at the biggest annual conferences of Chinese academic associations in the field of journalism and communication study, like The Chinese Association for History of Journalism and Mass Communication, Chinese Collegial Association for Visual Art, etc.
- Launch an initiative to encourage Chinese IAMCR PhD members to actively participate in various national and international academic activities and publish papers in the name of IAMCR member.

On task 6

• Establish dialogue mechanism with other ambassadors outside China where possible, to communicate and learn from each other on the work experience and knowledge.

• Create opportunities for connection, conversation and collaboration between the IAMCR members from different nations/regions based on the ambassadors' cooperation.
